ABSTRACT.

The Chief Minister's State Relief Fund and the Madras City Fire Relief Fund - Change in nomenclature of the former and merger of the latter - Orders issued.

ORDER:-

The following two funds were constituted in 1967:-

- (i) The Chief Minister's State Relief Fund; and
- (ii) The Madras City Fire Relief Fund.

2. In G.O.Ms.No. 729 Finance (S) Department dated 19-6-1971 the balances in the Madras Cyclone Relief Fund, 1955 were merged with the balance in the Chief Minister's State Relief Fund as the purposes of the two funds were similar. The Government now direct that the name of the Chief Minister's State Relief Fund be changed as Chief Minister's Public Relief Fund and that the balances in the Madras City Fire Relief Fund be merged with the Balances in the Chief Minister's Public Relief Fund, as both the funds are for granting reliefs for public purposes.
